On Flying Pond we have had loon eggs hatch, but none have survived in recent years. Eagles, turtles, skunks, raccoons, and human disturbance can all be deadly. PLEASE help our loons as much as you can by being respectful. Loons need plenty of room without being disturbed. Enjoy them – but keep a good, safe distance. It makes sense AND it's the law.
